A day hike past the mysterious Chartreuse Monastery and up to the summit of Grand Som where we will admire the monastery from above

To bring: 1.5 litres of water, picnic, good boots, hat, jacket, rain gear, sunscreen, sunglasses, as well as collapsible hiking poles (recommended); and for France: Euros, passport (and visa if necessary)

Transport: We will meet at 0730 for a 0745 departure by car at the parking lot near the Salle Communale de Chêne-Bougeries, Route du Vallon 1. The hike leader will drive the SCIG van and take 8 persons. Starting point: Trail head parking near the Chartreuse Monastery museum.

Club fee: CHF 5 for SCIG members and CHF 15 for non-members (TWINT preferable in either case)

Maximum participation: 12 persons

In case of bad weather: The hike will be cancelled in case of bad weather. I will send a confirmation email the day before the hike.

Hike information: We will hike approximately 13 km with a gain and loss of +/- 1200 m. Our highest point is 2026 m. There is a very steep segment, so do consider your ability. We will have our picnic at the summit of Grand Som, and then loop back to the trail head where we will have an additional hour to visit the museum of the Chartreuse Monastery. We will then return to Geneva; don't make early evening plans.

- By registering, you agree that you are fit for this level of hike and/or that you have previously participated in a similar hike with SCIG.
