### I need to know:

- Your full name, email address and mobile phone number
- Are you a SCIG member?
- Have you joined a similar hike (approx. 685 m gain and loss, over 7.5 km long)?

**To bring:** 1.5 litres of water, picnic, good boots, hat, jacket, rain gear, sunscreen, sunglasses, as well as collapsible hiking poles (recommended)

**Transport:** You will leave Gare Cornavin at 0829 on a train then post bus to Arolla via Sion and meet me and fellow hikers at Arolla Post where we'll start the hike (option to join my hike the previous day starting in Arolla, and spending the night in Arolla). Return buses are available from Arolla to Sion (with connections to Geneva) until 1804.

**Club fee:** CHF 5 for SCIG members and CHF 15 for non-members (TWINT preferable in either case)

**Maximum participation:** 12 persons

**Leader:** Scott Spence

**Assistant:** Pere Mora Romà

**In case of bad weather:** The hike will be cancelled in case of bad weather. I will send a confirmation email the day before the hike.

**Hike information:** We will start in Arolla and hike approximately 8 km with a gain and loss of +/- 685 m. Our highest point is 2680 m. There are no technical difficulties. We will have our picnic at the glacier, and then return on the same trail back to Arolla. This hike can be combined with one the previous day that I'm offering, also starting in Arolla. In this case you'll need to arrange your own accommodation in Arolla. If you're coming from Geneva you'll need to make sure you make the right connections to meet us in Arolla (see "Transport" above).



- By registering, you agree that you are fit for this level of hike and/or that you have previously participated in a similar hike with SCIG.
