

## Raquettes: Parcours du Savolaire

SATURDAY 27 JANUARY- MOYEN - VALAIS



The snowshoe trek leads up to the hill of Savolaire. At an altitude of 1,650 metres, you will have a fantastic view over the snow-covered Val de Morgins, the Rhone plain, the Vaud Alps and the majestic Dents du Midi mountain range.

The circular tour starts in the Lower Valais Mountain village of Morgins at an altitude of 1,300 metres from the Foilleuse chairlift and climbs along the forest's edge. As we climb the view opens over the many wooden chalets that line the valley with their snow-covered roofs. Shortly afterwards, the snowshoe trail enters the forest and winds its way steeply up to reach the hike's highest point and, during a picnic break, we can enjoy views over the Rhone plain, the Vaud Alps and the towering Dents du Midi chain. From Savolaire, the route continues downhill across snow-covered alpine meadows towards Champarin. The last section leads through the forest, before reaching the starting point in Morgins.

Maximum altitude: 1,650 m Elevation gain/loss: ±340 m

Distance:6 km

Walking time: About 3 hours


