La Cure – Le Noirmont – Le Croue – La Cure

This snowshoe hike in a beautiful region of the Jura, is relatively uncrowded compared to other places where ski lifts have flourished. The start is from La Cure 1155m where we walk along a flat path to Les Croppettes, then we veer off to the left and begin our gradual ascent to Le Noirmont. On a sunny day, in the glistening snow, the views of the surrounding Jura are exceptional. If there is little snow, we may only need clip-on crampons.
